

As you see, you are reported to have 85% European and 15% East Asian ancestry. All things being equal, the latter amount would correspond approximately to one great-grandparent who was East Asian. Bear in mind, however, that this test often confuses East Asian with Native American DNA.

Of the European ancestry, you are reported to have 51% Northern European, 22% Southeastern European, 14% Middle Eastern and 13% South Asian. Note that because of ancient migrations and gene pools, "Northern European" includes Spain, Portugal and France, countries not actually in Northern Europe, and that "Southeastern European" includes Italy and Turkey. "Middle Eastern" includes North Africa above the Sahara. "South Asian" designates Pakistani
